

Brookview Outdoor Recreation Park: Transforming Our Community Space

Join us in an exciting journey to revitalize the Brookview Outdoor Rink into the **Brookview Outdoor Recreation Park**. The outdoor rink at Brookview has been a cherished landmark in our community since 1991. Phase One: Rink Replacement

The first phase involves constructing a large concrete base rink suitable for ice hockey and family skating, complete with weather-resistant dasher boards and perimeter fencing. This new rink will also feature pickleball and basketball courts, as well as a multiuse area for activities such as badminton, lacrosse, ball hockey, and will accommodate other social events during the warmer months.

Additionally, plans include an enhanced skating-only area outside of the rink. We will install an energy-efficient LED lighting system to improve visibility and safety, and address drainage issues to ensure the stability and longevity of the rink.

Phase Two: Gathering Space Development

The second phase focuses on creating a larger, accessible outdoor gathering area for recreational activities and social events. This will include comfortable seating areas and shelters and shaded areas for relaxation and community bonding. Pathways will be developed and the area will be enhanced with functional and aesthetic landscaping and recreational features. Furthermore, a designated staging area will be included for community events and activities, providing a versatile space that meets the diverse needs of our residents.

Phase Three: Adding the Roof

The third phase involves adding a roof over the rink, significantly enhancing its usability throughout the year. In winter, the roof will reduce sun exposure and minimize ice melt, ensuring a consistently high-quality ice surface for skating and hockey. During the summer months, the roof will provide shade, making the rink an ideal venue for various sports like pickleball, basketball, and badminton, protecting players from sun and rain. Overall, a roof will extend the rink's usability, protect it from weather-related wear and tear, and create a more comfortable and versatile space for community activities year-round.
